

## **Addendum of Scientific Collaboration**

### **between the Japanese Society for Oral Health and the Korean Academy of Preventive Dentistry and Oral Health**

In order to strengthen collaborative scientific activities between the Japanese Society for Oral Health (JSOH) and the Korean Academy of Preventive Dentistry and Oral Health (KAPDOH), both institutions hereby agree in this addendum as follows:

1. To exchange scientific information, the JSOH (in odd years)/KAPDOH (in even years) shall invite a delegate to its annual meeting every other year. The JSOH/KAPDOH shall have an obligation to arrange accommodation (up to three nights) for the invited delegate. The host society/association shall pay for the transportation fare and lodging of the delegate throughout their stay. The airfare of the delegate shall be paid by the society/association to which the delegate belongs. The registration fee for the meeting shall not be charged. The compensation for delivering the lecture can be paid for if the president of the congress has advised, due to special circumstances such as an online congress, etc. The biography of the invited delegate and the title of their presentation, together with its abstract, shall be sent to the other institution's administrative office earlier than three months prior to the corresponding meeting.
2. To promote friendships and scientific activities among the members, the JSOH/KAPDOH shall encourage their members to participate in the other institution's scientific meetings. No membership fee shall be required for giving a presentation at the other institution's meetings for members of the JSOH or the KAPDOH. The fee for registration, as well as for reception, shall be consulted each time a particular case occurs.
3. Each year, up to ten papers shall be subjected to this addendum's regulations.
4. The administration office of each institution shall select the paper(s) for presentation and disclose the name of the author(s) and the title of the presentation(s) with its (their) abstract(s) to the other institution's administrative office earlier than three months prior to the corresponding meeting.
5. The date of the annual meeting shall be disclosed to the other party earlier than one year prior to the meeting through the administrative office.
6. The agreement shall become effective from the date of signing by both parties and shall be renewed every five years thereafter, unless either side notifies, in writing, the other of its intention to terminate the agreement. If either party finds that the memorandum is not beneficial to either party, then the memorandum can be terminated as from five years after the agreement. Exceptionally, this agreement shall be renewed in 2020, given that the previous agreement was signed in 2015.
